Science

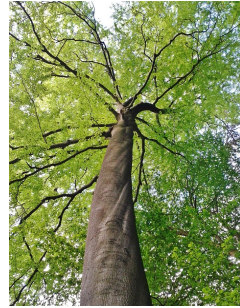

How can you help?

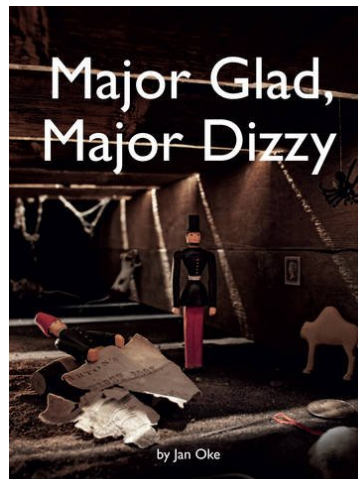
- Read with your child daily if possible.
