<p><u>Monday</u> <u>World Complement Day</u> Giving a complement can make a person feel good about themselves and brighten up their day. I would like you to write an acrostic poem for a special person in your life which complements them and tells them why they are special to you. This could be for a family member or friend.</p> 	<p><u>Tuesday</u> <u>Dr Seuss's Birthday</u> Dr Seuss has written many well know books, some of which have been made into films. Find out about the books he has written and recreate a piece of his unique and distinctive artwork.</p> 	<p><u>Wednesday</u> <u>World Wildlife Day</u> Many animals are critically endangered – this means that they are at the highest risk of extinction. I would like you research which animals are on this list and then decide which animal you would like design a fact sheet for. You will have to carefully research what animal you are going to choose because not all animals are critically endangered. See the example below (Brown bears are not critically endangered!)</p> 	<p><u>Thursday</u> <u>World Book Day</u> Spend some time reading a book from https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/ When you have read the book write an honest review explaining what you did and didn't like about it.</p>	<p><u>Friday</u> <u>National Day of Unplugging</u> Today you are going to design an eye-catching poster that explains the many benefits of unplugging and putting down electronic devices. Do some research first because there are many beneficial reasons for doing this. Remember: Less is more. If someone cannot read your poster from a few meters away then it isn't doing its job!</p>
